Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Arrive Kathmandu

On arrival at the Kathmandu airport meet with our office executive assistance & transfer to Hotel. Rest time free and easy for personal activities relax. Overnight at hotel.

Day 02: Kathmandu

Breakfast at the hotel. AM: Sightseeing tour of Kathmandu City + Swayambhunath. Kathmandu City: Known as Kantipur, the capital of the Kingdom of Nepal. Here you will visit the temple of the Living Goddess. Kasthamandap - the source of the name Kathmandu and supposed to be made from the timber of a single tree and the Durbar Square are with its array of temples overlooked by the Hanuman Dhoka Palace, the ancient palace of the Nepalese Royalty.

Swayambhunath: this Buddhist Stupa is said to be 2000 years old. The Stupa which forms the main structure is composed of a solid hemisphere of brick and earth supporting a lofty conical spire capped by a pinnacle of copper gilt. Painted on the four sided base of the spire are the all seeing eyes of Lord Buddha. This hill is a mosaic of small Chaityas and Pagoda temples.



PM: Sightseeing tour of Patan City also known as Lalitpur is the city of fine arts, enclosed within 4 stupas said to be built in 3rd century AD by



Emperor Ashoka. You will see the Durbar Square, the Patan Durbar which houses a bronze collection, the Krishna temple built by King Siddhi Narsingh Malla, Hiranya Varna Mahavir and Mahaboudha Temple.

A trip to the Tibetan Refugee Camp and the Handicraft Centre will also be done while, visiting Patan where you will witness the hand weaving of Tibetan carpets and moldings of metal statues. Overnight at hotel.

Day 03: Kathmandu – Pokhra (200kms/ 5-6hrs approx)

Breakfast at hotel, drive to Pokhara check in at hotel. Visit scenic view points.

Pokhara one of the most picturesque valley in Nepal, under the shadow of the Annapurna Himalayan range. A rare combination of snow-clad mountains, crystal clear lakes, streams, villages inhabited by friendly ethnic tribes. Famous for a clean water lakes, seti rivers with subline natural beauty and Himalayan views. It is the gateway to Nepal's West. Many of nepals most diverse and interesting treks and rafting experiences are on the doorstep of pokhara. From here Annapurna Mustang, Manaslu, Chitwan, Dolpa, Jumla, Humla the holy mountains of mt Kailash, lumbini, Tansen, and Gorkha are all within easy reach. Pokhara is the placed to relax in Nepal. The famous places of pokhara are phewa Tal, Rupa Tal, Begnas tal, Patale Chhango, Davids falls, Mahendra Cave, Seti River, Ram ghat, Bindhyabasini Temple, Buddhist Monastery Mahendra Pul The ACAP Natural History Museum, Lumle, chandrakhot, Kaskikhot, Dampus, Sarankot, Tulakot, Kahun Danda and world peace Pagada. Evening boat ride in Phewa Lake. Overnight at hotel.

Day 04: Pokhara

Breakfast at hotel early morning excursion to Sarangkot (1,592 m), a former Kaski fort lying atop a



hill 5 km west of the old bazaar; Kahundanda (1,520 m), to the north-east of Pokhara, which has a ruined fort on the summit as well as a view tower; and Ghachowk, a typical Gurung village and the site of one of the region's oldest settlements, is a five-hour walk to the north of Pokhara. The ancient fort of Nuwakot, 15 km south of Devi's Fall, is also ideal for savoring the splendors of nature.

Naudanda is a five-hour walk and a favorite with those wishing to get away from it all.



PM: Sightseeing of Pokhara: The Pokhara Valley is one of the most picturesque spots of Nepal. The beauty of the Valley is enhanced by its lovely lakes Phewa, Begnas, and Rupa. Which have their source in the glacial region of the Annapurna Range of the Himalayas. Pokhara is located at an altitude of 900 meters from the see-level. Pokhara offers the magnificent views of Dhaulagiri, Manaslu, Machchha-puchhre mountain & five peaks of Annuapurna and others. Pokhara is one of the few places in the world to provide dramatic views in a subtropical setting. Overnight at hotel.

Day 05: Pokhara - Chitwan (160kms/ 4-5hrs approx)

After breakfast depart on the 6-hour drive to the Royal Chitwan National Park. The road goes through the foothills, along the Trisuli river, before reaching the plains of the Terai. Arrive and check in to the lodge/ resort. Overnight at lodge.

Day 06: Chitwan

Early morning and late afternoon game viewing by jeep or elephant.

With the most exotic and endangered species inhabiting the areas, one gets to witness a diverse wildlife population within a limited area in a short time frame. There are 56 species of animals, 49 species of amphibians and reptiles and 525 species of birds making it a paradise for the nature lovers and biodiversity enthusiasts. The most sought out animals include the one-



horned-rhinoceros, Bengal tigers, four-horned antelope, leopards, sloth bear, rhesus monkey and many others. The cobras, pythons, marsh crocodiles, Gharials and freshwater dolphins are other attractions that provide the exotic touch to the wildlife of Chitwan. The visit to the crocodile breeding center is also a fun experience during the stay. Wildlife is one of the main attractions of the Chitwan.

The Lodge staff will brief you on the area and the other activities available, such as day hikes, nature walks, bird watching and game viewing from machans (blinds). Overnight at lodge.

Day 07: Chitwan – Kathmandu (160kms/ 4hrs approx)



Breakfast at hotel, drive to Kathmandu, check in at hotel.

Afternoon city tour visiting **Pashupatinath temple** one of the holiest temples dedicated to Lord Shiva. Situated amidst a lush green natural setting on the bank of the sacred Bagmati River, the temple built in pagoda style has gilted roof and richly carved silver doors. Visitors will be permitted to view the temple from the east bank of Bagmati River, entrance in the temple being strictly forbidden to all non-Hindus. Pashupatinath is the center of annual pilgrimage on the day of shivaratri which falls in the month of February/March. Behind the temple are the cremation grounds.

Also visit **Bodhnath** one of the biggest in the world of its kind. It stands with four pairs of eyes in the four cardinal direction keeping watch for righteous behavior and human prosperity. This Buddhism Stupa was built by King Man Deva at the advice of the Goddess Mani Jogini. It is built on an octagonal base inset with prayer wheels. The shrine is ringed by houses of Lamas or Buddhist priest. Overnight at hotel.

Day 08: Kathmandu - Bhaktapur - Nagarkot (32kms/ 1hrs approx)



Breakfast at hotel drive to Nagarkot via visiting Bhaktapur "the city of devotees" in the Sanskrit

language. Bhaktapur is the home of medieval art and architecture. Lying 14kms east of Kathmandu City, this place was founded in the 9th Century and is shaped like a conch shell. The city is at the height of 4600 ft. above sea level. Visit the Durbar Square with its array of temples overlooked by the Palace of 55 windows built by King Bupatindra Malla. The Nyatapola

Temple, also built by King Bhupatindra Malla, is the best example of Pagoda style and stands on five terraces on each of which stands a pair of figures - two famous strong men, two elephants, two lions, two griffins and two goddesses. Time permitting, a visit to the museum of Thanka painting can also be considered.

Continue drive to Nagarkot check in at resort. Nagarkot has a classic panorama of the Himalayas situated at a height of 2195 meters. This resort town is famous for its sunrise and sunset views and even offers glimpses of Mt. Everest in the east on a clear morning while the entire Langtang range looms right in front. Overnight at resort.

Day 09: Nagarkot - Kathmandu - Departure

Breakfast at the hotel. Free till departure transfer to airport for Kathmandu onward flight.
